

Sydney Visual Arts Academy Terms and Conditions

Bullying or misbehaviour:

SVA Academy has a zero tolerance to bullying and discrimination. This includes and is not limited to verbal, physical and cyber bullying(harassment) during or outside the art studio. All instances of bullying will be dealt with by necessary means by SVA Academy staff. If bullying is still occurring, SVA Academy reserves the right to instantly dismiss or withdraw the student.

Students who are disruptive will be given a warning and if the behaviour continues, parents will be contacted immediately to remove their child from the class.

Unforeseen class interruptions:

SVA Academy will endeavour to ensure all classes are not interrupted from the schedule, however there may be the odd occasion where classes are cancelled due to a pandemic, a natural disaster or other unforeseeable circumstances. In this case, we will offer credit, a refund or an alternative lesson.

Photography & Video:

By enrolling in SVA Academy parents are giving permission for photos of students and their work to be used for promotional purposes. However, if you would not like photos of your child on social media and our website, please inform us via email.

SVA Academy requests that parents and students do not take photos or video footage of any images of artworks or class materials, and other children, without the consent of the staff and/or parents.

Personal information Privacy:

We are committed to the safe collection of personal information. We respect the rights of all our students and will not share sensitive information with any third party.

Enrolment and Fees.

1. To enrol, you will firstly need to call or email to check class availability. Classes are kept small to allow for individual tuition.
2. After receiving confirmation of a place in the class, you will need to fill in the enrolment form, which can be found on the Contacts/Enrol page on the SVA Academy website.
3. To secure your enrolment, term fees must be made before attending the class. Fees are based on the term and are non-refundable. Payment deductions only apply in the following instances: state or local emergencies, COVID lockdowns, public holidays, new students enrolling mid-term or

cancellation of lessons by SVA Academy due to unforeseen class interruptions.

4. Students can do a maximum of 3 make-up lessons, during the same term subject to class availability.
5. Students must be picked up on time or a late collection fee will apply. \$20 for the first 5-10 mins late. After this time, it will be \$20 per 10 mins until the child is collected.
6. Enrolment is on condition of accepting the above terms and conditions.
